Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 3rd ultimo relative to the case of your steamer "VINCAS".

S. Your remarks in regard to the 2nd Special Survey No.3 have been carefully noted by the Committee who have again had the case under consideration, and I am directed to inform you that whilst they would be only too pleased to meet your wishes in the matter if it were at all possible, as you cannot arrange for the Special Survey to be carried out, they regret they cannot agree to leave the matter of the survey in abeyance, as desired.

In these circumstances your request to withdraw the vessel's class has been acceded to, and instructions have accordingly been given for three dots (...) to be inserted in lieu of the class, indicating withdrawal at Owners' request.

I may add that, should at any time you find it possible to carry out the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.3 with a view to the re-instatement of the class, and will approach the Society's Surveyors at Melbourne in the matter, the case will receive every attention.
