With reference to my letter of 14th ult. I beg to advise that in view of the fact that steamer was fixed for the transport of a cargo of Coal from EMDEN to Greece for account of the GREEK GOVERNMENT, in spite of my endeavours Charterers have not given their consent for an extension of the cancelling date of the respective Charter-Party, of which they claimed the immediate execution, so that I have not been able to complete ship's Special Survey No.1 at GHENT, as proposed by my aforesaid letter.--

Steamer is now on her way to Greece and am prepared to arrange for the completion of the survey No.1 at PIRAEUS after discharging and request you to communicate the above to your London Head Office, if you consider it necessary.--
