Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of yesterday's date regarding the proposed reclassification of the steamer "DIONI", I beg to inform you that the brokers of this vessel had telephoned to us from Emden on the 14th instant requesting us on behalf of the Captain to give the vessel a certificate of seaworthiness for a voyage from Emden to a Port in Greece with a cargo of coal. The brokers were then informed that, as the vessel's class was expunged with a red line, we could not give a certificate of seaworthiness and that, to obtain this, the Owners would have to make an application for reinstatement of class.

After this we did not hear anything more from the brokers. On receipt of your above letter I have now telephoned to the brokers and they informed me that the vessel would leave to-morrow for Saloniki with a cargo of coal.
