Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant confirming the exchange of cablegrams which have passed between us relative to the case of the steamer "DIONI" and have now received your further cablegram of the 16th instant, which decoded reads as follows:-

"DIONI Owners desire further Committee's consideration
"in this special case Owners state S.S.No.1 will be
"completed on arrival at Ghent where vessel is due
"25th instant cable reply matter very urgent".

In connection with this case I may say that since the despatch of my cablegram to you of the 7th instant, two further cablegrams have been received from the Owner from Athens asking for extension to enable the vessel to complete the voyage for which she is at present chartered, and the Owner has been informed that the Committee must adhere to their previous decision as conveyed in my letter to the Owner of the 4th instant, a copy of which was forwarded to you.

In view of your cablegram of yesterday's date the case was again considered by the General Committee at their Meeting to-day, and I have to say that they are not prepared to modify their previous decision.

I therefore cabled to you as per copy herewith.

If the Owner now intends definitely to carry out the survey on the vessel's arrival at Ghent, the vessel will be eligible to have her class reinstated on receipt of a report that all the requirements of the survey and repairs have been carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owner accordingly.
