Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your further cablegram of the 10th instant relative to your steamer "DIONI", and have to say that the case has received the careful consideration of the General Committee of this Society at their meeting today, when they again had all the facts before them.

They regret, however, that they cannot grant any further extension of the classification to permit of the vessel making the voyage from Poti to Ghent and back before completing the survey, and they have accordingly now given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
