A proposal to complete the Special Survey within the year of grace was agreed to by the Committee.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.

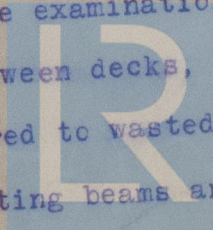
