The 3<sup>rd</sup> anchor is 5 lbs. less in weight than required by Table 22, but the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> (stockless) anchors are 52 lbs. and 122 lbs. respectively in excess.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed + 100 A 1 ("Steel") "Steam Trawler" as recommended.
