s.s. "JEBBA" now named "THALIA"

This vessel's class was continued for some time as the vessel was laid up and the late Owners, Messrs. Elder Dempster & Co., Ltd., gave the usual undertaking in regard to the Special Survey No.3 which became due in September 1929.

The vessel subsequently became the property of Messrs. A. Constantinidis & E. Xilas, who converted the vessel to a shelter deck type with tonnage opening, and the work was carried out under the inspection of the British Corporation Surveyors, it being intended to transfer the classification to that Society. *at summary*

The class was accordingly expunged with a Red Line.

In a letter received on the 23rd October from Mr. Xilas, one of the Owners, it was stated that the vessel had completed her Special Survey No.3 all necessary repairs having been carried out under the supervision of the Surveyor to the British Corporation.

Enquiry has been made of the British Corporation and it is confirmed that the vessel is now classed with that Society. It is understood that the vessel is now at Antwerp where she is loading a general cargo.

The posting of the change of name in the Society's Register Book is being commenced today.
