The Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel
in September, 1929, and no part has been held.

She has been laid up in the Dart, and the usual
undertaking was duly furnished by the late Owners.

On the 26th ultimo information was received at this
Office that the vessel was purchased from Messrs. Elder,
Dempster & Co. by the Tramp Steamship Development Co. and
had been re-sold to the present Owners, who were converting
her to a Shelter Deck type, with Tonnage Opening. It was
stated the work was being carried out by the Crew, with
assistance from the shore, and to the satisfaction of the
British Corporation Surveyors, it being intended to transfer
the classification to that Society.

On the 28th ultimo a letter was received from the
previous Owners confirming that the new Owners had decided
to class the vessel with the British Corporation.

The year of grace expired in September, 1930.

The Classing Committee had the case before them
on Friday, 29th ultimo, when, in view of all the circumstances,
they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to
be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (9.33),
indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the
interested parties have been informed accordingly.
