

Dear Sir,

S. With reference to your letter, dated Hamburg 7th June last, relative to the steamer "PRESTO", and to your promise to the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg that the Second Special Survey No.2 of this vessel would be completed on her arrival at Boulogne, I beg to inform you that on the 28th June the Society's Surveyor at that port stated that the vessel would not remain a sufficient length of time at Boulogne to complete the survey, but that it would be undertaken at Rotterdam, whither the vessel was proceeding.

The vessel subsequently arrived at Cardiff, and I am informed by the Society's Surveyors at that port that she has sailed for Genoa without anything being done towards the completion of the survey.

The case has accordingly been submitted to the General Committee at their meeting today, and I have to say that in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of this inspection expired so long ago as November, 1931, they have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the
