Dear Sir,

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 13th inst. respecting the case of the s.s. "PRESTO" and as requested have discussed the matter with Mr. Cappiello, the Owner of the vessel. Mr. Cappiello states that the ship is expected to arrive in Boulogne on the 24th instant and that he is travelling to Boulogne in order to receive the ship there. After arrival in Boulogne Mr. Cappiello intends to make the necessary arrangements in order to have the survey completed during the vessel's stay at that Port. Should for any reason it not be possible for him to carry out all the remaining requirements at Boulogne then the rest will be done at Rotterdam, whither she is proceeding in ballast, before loading another cargo.

It is presumed that you will advise the Boulogne Surveyor as to what remains to be done in order to complete 2nd Special Survey No 2 in the case of this vessel.
