Dear Sir,

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo respecting the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.2 of the steamer "PRESTO",

It is now observed from the Shipping Papers that the vessel has now left Nicolaieff for Boulogne, and sailed from Istanbul on the 8th instant.

In the circumstances it is desired that you should at once get into touch with the Owner, Mr.S.Cappiello, of your Port, and ascertain definitely at what port the vessel will complete her discharge as the Committee must require that the remaining items of the survey be completed before the vessel loads another cargo.

The Owner will no doubt appreciate that the record of 2nd S.S.No.2 cannot be made in the Register Book until the remaining items of the survey are carried out, and as the year of grace allowed for the completion of this survey expired so long ago as 11,31, he must realise that the Committee cannot allow the matter to remain over after the vessel has discharged her cargo at a Continental port.
