Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that in January last the Committee agreed to the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.2 of the steamer "PRESTO" being postponed until the vessel's arrival in the U.K., on completion of the voyage Genoa, Black Sea to U.K., on the understanding that this arrangement would be adhered to without fail.

In April the Owner stated that the vessel was still at Nicolaieff awaiting a cargo, and that he would advise this Office as soon as her port of destination was known.

In reply to further enquiry the Owner's Agents have advised the Genoa Surveyors that the Owner is resident in Hamburg and that they have been unable to obtain any information from him.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will get into touch with the Owner, Mr. S. Cappiello, Welserhaus, Hamburg, and let me know whether he is yet in a position to say where the survey will be completed.
