I hasten to inform you that in spite of all my best intentions and the promise made in accordance with instructions issued by the General Direction of Lloyd's Register London, I find it absolutely impossible to carry out here at Genoa ^{the small & insignificant items} ~~what remains~~ to complete the S.S.N°2 because of the fact that I have not been able to recharter the steamer with a later cancelling date and there remains no possibility whatsoever for the carrying out of the foregoing, as the steamer "PRESTO" must leave immediately on completion of discharge in order not to break the charter.

The above mentioned work will be dealt with on the vessel's arrival at a U.K. Port where she will go to discharge her cargo for Russia whither she is now bound.
