Dear Sirs,


I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant with reference to the survey held at your port on the Steamer "MILLUNA" ex "FRANZISKA" with a view to classification in the Society's Register Book, and in reply have to acquaint you that in the circumstances it is considered that an inclusive fee of £120 should be charged for the survey of the hull and machinery for classification, with an additional £10 for the survey of damage repairs that have been carried out in this instance.

The above amounts should be allocated as £100 for the hull survey and £30 for the machinery survey.

I shall be glad if you will render an account accordingly and pass the amount through your books in the usual way.
