"Achille Lauro - Following remains to be done to complete "s.s. No. 3 as regards Hull:- Examination of holds, examination "of bilges in crossbunker and in boiler space, examination "of engine space below floors, examination of fore peak "tank spaces above peaks, examination of plating in way of "sidelights, examination of windlass, examination of steering "gear, examination of masts and rigging, examination of "general equipment, examination of air and sounding pipes "with doublings, examination of hand pumps, watertight tunnel "doors, internal examination of double bottom tanks Nos. "1, 4 and 5, 2 forward of crossbunker, testing of double "bottom tanks, testing of peak tanks, verification of "freeboard; Boiler space tank top requires to be repaired; "Leakage from riveting double bottom tank N° 2 starboard side "and decks and casings in lower tween deck bunkers, pocket "bunkers, requires to be repaired."
