Dear Sir:

On checking over the bower anchors for the S.S. "CANADIAN EXPLORER" (the Halifax Shipyards' Hull No. 2), it was found the collective weight was not sufficient, and on looking over the weights of the anchors for the S.S. "CANADIAN MARINER" it was found that the collective weight of these was more than sufficient. It was surmised that one of these anchors had been placed on the wrong vessel. As the steamer "CANADIAN MARINER" had returned from her maiden voyage the anchor (certificate No. 60) was changed for the anchor with certificate No. 59, thus giving the collective weight to both vessels. Enclosed please find particulars of the anchor, certificate No. 59, replacing anchor with certificate No. 60, which is being used for the S.S. "CANADIAN EXPLORER". The certificates for these have been altered accordingly.
