INDIAN NAVAL AUXILIARY LOST
NEW DELHI, Thursday
The *Sophie Marie*, an auxiliary vessel of the Royal Indian Navy, has been lost, it was officially announced to-day. Two of the Indian ratings were killed, but the remainder of the ship's company were saved.—British United Press.

The *Sophie Marie*, built in a German yard in 1923, was of 1138 tons gross and 677 tons net. She was formerly owned by the Merchant Steam Navigation Company, of Bombay.
