With reference to the entries which have appeared from time to time in your returns of vessels under survey, I shall be glad to learn how this case now stands.



The Owners have kept this vessel continually in service during the survey with only occasional stays in port of three or four days duration, during which time cargo was usually being worked. This accounts for the lengthy period over which the survey has been conducted.

The vessel was drydocked and the boilers were tested recently, and the survey is now nearing completion. I hope to forward the report by next week's mail.
