The 2nd S.S. No.1, due 4,32, has been partly held by the examination of the bottom and rudder in dry dock, decks, masts and rigging.

Repairs are required to the steering chains, after rigging and engine room ventilators.

The case received consideration on the 28th April last when action was deferred.

In reply to enquiry the Cadiz Surveyor now writes as follows:-
