H. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the steamer "SILVERGRAY", and in reply I have to say that in the circumstances you mention the Committee, who have had the case before them at their meeting today, have further deferred consideration of the same for the present subject to a complete Boiler Survey and the Screwshaft Survey being carried out before she is again placed in commission.

The Committee are also agreeable to the Special Survey No.3 being postponed for the present, provided it be carried out sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules, i.e. by the end of July, 1933.
