Reverting to your letter of the 1st July last respecting the steamer "GIULIA PEIRCE", I send herewith for your information a copy of a damage survey report received from the Society's Surveyors at Havre. I may say that I have informed the Surveyors that this vessel has been partly surveyed with a view to classification and that it is intended to complete the survey on her return to Italy, and in the circumstances they are being asked to state whether the repairs recommended in their report were carried out under their inspection, and if not, how the case stands.

It is concluded that this steamer has by now returned to Italy and I shall be glad to learn in due course what arrangements have been made with a view to the survey for classification being completed.
