With reference to your letter of the 9th instant, respecting the survey held by Mr. Roberts and Mr. Ives, the Society's Principal Surveyor for the Continent, on the construction of the S.S. "GUILIA" (C.B.No.12) building by the Societa Anonima Bacini E Scala Napoletani and giving details of the equivalent compensation arranged for, I have to acquaint you that the remarks contained therein have been very carefully noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements, with the compensation arranged for, are equivalent to the requirements of the Rules and that provided upon completion of the vessel a satisfactory report be received the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100 A.I.

The question of the assignment of the mark \* indicating that the vessel has been surveyed during construction will be deferred pending the result of the examination of the vessel in dry dock by Mr. Roberts, when the shell and its riveting should be carefully examined, rivets being cut out at different parts, in order to ascertain more closely the quality of the workmanship, as arranged by Mr. Ives.
