Plans of midship section, profile and deck and bulkheads, submitted by the Naples Surveyors.

This vessel is a sister ship of the Builders C.B. 13 ^{for which} whose plans were approved on 18th June 1920 for the class 100A.1.

C.B. 12; "GIULIA" is now launched and the engines and boilers are being fitted into place, and it is expected the vessel will be completed in June.

The Builders are now desirous that she should receive the 100 A.1. class and in making this request on behalf of the Builders the Surveyor states:- "We enclose herewith for your consideration the plans of C.B. 12 also the approved plans of C.B. 13 for guidance, and respectfully suggest the plans of C.B. 12 might be treated on the same basis as C.B. 13".

It is therefore submitted that as C.B. 12. is the same in all respects as C.B. 13 the plans already approved for C.B. 13 should receive the additional number of C.B. 12, and as Mr. Ives is at present in Italy he should be requested ^{by wire} to visit Naples and join Mr. Roberts in the survey of C.B. 12 and report upon the workmanship in the vessel, also whether the work is too far advanced to allow of the special survey mark (*) being recommended in this case.

The steel used in the construction of the vessel was made in America and tested by the Society's Surveyors, and Mr. Roberts states that the Certificates have been seen.

Plans for C.B. 12 are being retained in this Office. Plans for C.B. 13 additionally marked C.B. 12 to be returned to Naples Surveyors.
