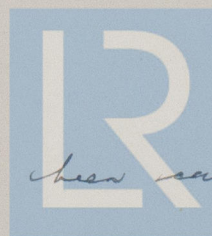
The Shanghai Surveyors forward a letter from the Owners to the effect that owing to depression of business it has been decided to suspend the classification of all their vessels.
