
I have to forward herewith copy and free translation of Owners' letters of 17th and 27th ultimo in which it will be seen they indicate request to withdraw class of vessel from this Society for reasons of economy.

As will be seen from Weekly List of Vessels that have come under Survey and have not been reported (Rtn.3) dated 16/2/34, the Special Survey has been commenced at this port and our attendance was at Owners' request; during the course of the survey the Owners' letter of 17th inst. was received at this Office.

I have been in touch with the Owners' General Manager and as a result of this the matter was reconsidered by the Owners' directors who could not however see their way to recede from the decision taken.

The General Manager spontaneously expressed Owners' appreciation of the careful survey made by Surveyors from this Office during construction and when the vessel was converted from Cargo Ship to Oil Tanker at Spezia in 1930.
