The 2nd Special Survey No.3 became due in March 1933, and no part of the survey has been held.

Action has previously been deferred by the Classing Committee as the vessel has been laid up at Gothenburg, and, owing to the death of the late Owner, no undertaking was requested.

In March last the Classing Committee agreed to the vessel leaving Gothenburg for Antwerp (in the event, her sale to Belgian purchasers being completed), provided a satisfactory examination of the vessel and the Boiler Survey were carried out before she left Gothenburg, and the Special Survey carried out on her arrival at Antwerp.

The sale was completed and the vessel, after the necessary inspections at Gothenburg, duly arrived at Antwerp.

The Antwerp Surveyors were informed of the case and in reply wrote on the 23rd ultimo that on making the new Owners informed them that their attendance was required as the vessel was being classed with the Antwerp Corporation.

The year of grace expired 3,34.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 27th ultimo, when they decided to give the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (4,34), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the new Owners have been so informed.
