
Sir,

Herewith we beg to forward for the consideration of the Committee, a letter received from Mr. W. Walker, having reference to the stream anchor proposed to be supplied to his S.S. No 92 vessel, from which will be seen that "this is 6 lbs lighter than required by the Rules."

The weight of the stream anchor required by Table 22 is 4 cwt, and the weight of the proposed anchor is 3 cts, 3 qrs, 22 lbs.

The approved plan of midship section and test certificate of proposed anchor are enclosed for reference.
