Reverting to my letter of the 24th June last respecting the Steamer "WUGO MARU", I have to confirm my cablegram today as follows:-

WUGOMARU	=	Vessel's name
WEHVU	=	has freeboard been correctly marked & verified
WHONX	=	in order to complete survey for classification
VETWA	=	If not state
VLIEB	=	what arrangements have been made to....

I have to add that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Hong Kong, from which it appears that the vessel has been examined afloat after striking some unknown object.

The double bottom tanks were partly examined internally and the cement was found started on the starboard side of No. 3 tank.

As there was no sign of leakage in the tanks or bilges, the Surveyors recommended the vessel to be placed in dry dock for further examination at the Owners' convenience.
