Dear Sirs,

S. I have to inform you that the steamer "COASTER" (No.07944 in the Register Book) has for some time past been laid up in the Tyne under an undertaking in respect of the overdue Third Special Survey No.1.

A telegram has to-day been received from the Newcastle Surveyors stating that the vessel has been sold as she lies without class, and that she is to leave the Tyne to-day in tow, the purchasers being Messrs. Brechin of Granton.

It is understood the vessel has been sold to be broken up, and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to advise me in due course when it is expected demolition will be commenced.

I may add that in view of the circumstances of the case, the General Committee, at their meeting to-day, gave instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
