The Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in June, 1932.

The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne since October, 1933 and the usual undertaking was furnished by the Owners.

On the 25th instant the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle stated that the vessel had been sold for breaking up and it was understood would proceed to the Firth of Forth for the purpose, but the Owners did not wish to divulge the name of the purchasers.

The Surveyors were informed on the 27th instant that it was concluded that the vessel had been sold as she lies, but that she could not be moved as a classed ship without the sanction of the Committee.

The following telegram from the Newcastle Surveyors has just come to hand, this morning :-

"YOUR LETTER COASTER SOLD AS LIES WITHOUT CLASS WILL LEAVE TYNE TODAY IN TOW PURCHASER BRECHIN OF GRANTON"
