Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to your letter of the 25th instant respecting the case of the steamer "COASTER", which I note the Owners have informed you has been sold for breaking up and is to be taken to the Firth of Forth for that purpose, I have to inform you that it is concluded that she has been sold as she lies.

It will, of course, be understood that the vessel cannot be moved as a classed ship without the sanction of the Committee, and you will be good enough to keep me fully informed of any further developments, and whether there is any likelihood of a certificate being required for her passage to the Firth of Forth.

In the event of it being the intention to move the vessel without your being further advised, you should at once inform me, by telegram if necessary.
