The 3rd S.S.No.1 became due in 6,32 and a proposal to take advantage of the year of grace was agreed to by the Committee in view of a satisfactory general examination held at Newcastle in September 1932.

The vessel was laid up in October 1933, and the usual undertaking was furnished.

The Newcastle Surveyors now state that the vessel has been sold for breaking up and is to be taken to the Firth of Forth in about a week's time. The Owners do not wish to divulge the name of the purchaser in the meantime, but state that he is aware of the position as regards classification.

It is submitted that when the name of the purchaser is known, he might be asked to state if he desires the vessel to proceed to her breaking up port as a classed ship.
