With reference to the correspondence which passed between us in the early part of last month regarding the steamer "COASTER", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case before them today together with a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle intimating that after discharging her cargo she is to be laid up in the Tyne.
