Dear Sir,

S/S "COASTER"

We confirm telephone conversation of this afternoon when we specially mentioned this steamer on which the two months extension which the Committee granted us is now expiring.

This steamer is now in the TYNE and will be discharged tonight. We do not wish to appear unduly pressing in our applications but we are most anxious to keep the steamers trading as long as possible as in the present state of affairs any steamer which has to be stopped for Survey purposes must necessarily go to the Buoys and be laid up. We wish to avoid this as far as possible and think there are reasonable chances of getting something done in the course of another month or so.

We therefore ask the Committee to oblige us by granting another one or two months extension for the "COASTER" and then if the circumstances are not changed we shall have to be content with the position and tie her up. We believe that there is a little better feeling in the shorter trades and that this may justify additional money being spent on Surveys. We commend this boat to your special consideration and hope you will grant our request. If you will be good enough to telegraph us the Committee's decision we will be glad to refund.
