

S.S. "TYNESIDER".

Mr. T. E. Brown, of Messrs. Robinson, Brown & Co., has telephoned asking that the Committee will be good enough to grant him a two months extension before insisting on the Second Special Survey No.2 being carried out.

He stated that he has an opportunity of accepting a short charter from Thursday next, and in view of the present difficult times he is most anxious to be in a position to fix the vessel, and he asks the special indulgence of the Committee for the extension desired.

He added that if the Committee will not meet him in this case, it means that he must lay the vessel up, and as several of his other vessels are laid up, it will be seen that this is a matter of great importance to him.
