Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 6th instant enclosing one from the Owners of the steamer "COASTER", in which they ask for a six months' extension before completing the Third Special Survey No.1, I have to inform you that the Committee had the case under consideration at their meeting to-day.

With regard thereto the Committee regret that they are unable to grant such an extension as the Owners desire, although they are anxious to meet them in the special circumstances as far as they possibly can.

The Owners must quite understand that the Society's Rules do not permit of any extension beyond the year of grace which is provided for, but as a special concession in this case they have made an exception and have agreed to an extension until the 31st August.

You will therefore be good enough to inform the Owners accordingly and make it clear to them that no further extension beyond the time stated can be considered.
