Notes of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92).

The 3rd S.S.No.1 became due 6,32 and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to, provided the hull and machinery of the vessel be generally examined and favourably reported upon.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat and a general examination made of the Hold above ceiling, machinery spaces, decks, hatchways, casings, etc., and found in an efficient condition, and in the Surveyors' opinion the owners' proposal merits approval.

It is submitted action be deferred.

The Certificate of Classification to be endorsed "Cargo battens not fitted" and the same notation to be printed in the Register Book.
