The class is subject to fire damage in way of Nos. 4 & 5 holds being permanently repaired at the first available opportunity.

The 1st S.S. No.3 will become due at the end of this month.

(The Owners' Representative stated last month that the vessel will be 12 years old in August when it is proposed to withdraw her from class.)

The London Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

The fire damage, as above, has not been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 7,33 subject as above.
