CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS LAID UP.

With reference to the list of vessels laid up under an undertaking, I am directed to acquaint you, for the confidential information of the Committee of Lloyd's, that the case of the s.s. "TORLAK" (No. 36601 in Register Book) has been under consideration, together with a request that the vessel may be allowed to proceed in ballast from Aalesund to Leith, to be broken up, and that this request has been agreed to, subject to the vessel being surveyed by the Society's Bergen Surveyor, before sailing, in accordance with approved instructions.
