With reference to your letter of the 5th. September last respecting the steamer "Toblak" laid up at Aalesund I beg to inform you that I was informed today by the owner's agents at this port that this vessel had been sold to Scotland for breaking up purposes and they had been informed that instructions had been sent me by the Metal Industries Co. Ltd. to proceed to Aalesund to issue a certificate of seaworthiness after a general examination.

I understand this vessel is to proceed in ballast to Scotland and I shall be glad to know if bottom survey, screwshaft survey and boilersurvey must be held in this instance.

I have so far not received any instructions about any survey.

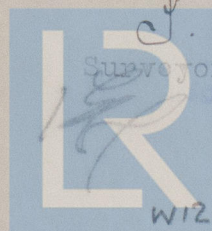
