With reference to my letter of the 9th September last I shall be glad to learn whether this vessel is still laid up.

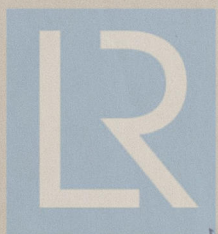
I shall also be glad to learn the Owners intentions regarding the hull Survey which is now due.
