This case is fully stated in endorsement dated 7.8.34, when the Greenock Surveyors were advised (in connexion with a proposal to take the vessel to Rotterdam for use as a store ship) that if the vessel left their port without being inspected by them they should immediately inform this Office, as her class could not otherwise be maintained for the voyage and must at once be expunged.

The Greenock Surveyors now state by telegram that they have received a letter from the Owners' Superintendent stating that the vessel left Lamlash in tow last Tuesday.

It is submitted that the class of this vessel be expunged.


