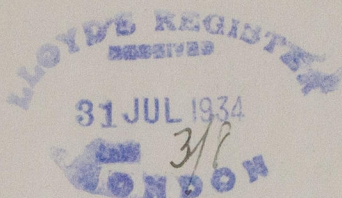

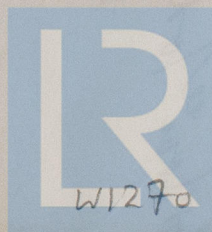
The Surveyors further state that the vessel is reported to have proceeded up the Amazon River with troops.
