
The Thai Maritime Navigation Co.Ltd. have purchased

These vessels will all be registered in Bangkok. The first has arrived, the second is due in a few days and the arrival of the third is not yet known.

These vessels were withdrawn from Lloyd's Register in 1935, and the new owners have now asked what formalities would be necessary should they wish to re-class the vessels.

I have informed them that at least a 2nd Special Survey No.2 would be required, and I presume that the vessels would not require to be re-measured, as it is stated that no alterations of any kind have been made.
