This case is fully stated in endorsement dated 3.9.34, when the Committee required a general examination in accordance with Circular No.1605 to be held to enable the vessel to proceed to Italy to be broken up.


Messrs. Michalinos & Co., in reply to the Secretary's letter informing them of the Committee's decision, requested that the vessel might be granted a certificate for the above purpose without being submitted to survey, and they were informed that this could not be acceded to and that if the vessel left Salonica the matter would be brought to the notice of the Committee with a view to the class being dealt with.


The Piraeus Surveyors were advised and requested to cable this Office immediately should the vessel proceed.

A cablegram has now been received from the Surveyors stating the vessel is reported to have left Salonica for Laurium and that no survey has been held.

Messrs. Michalinos & Co. have been communicated with by telephone and state they have not received cabled advice of the vessel having left but they believe she has sailed. It appears she is going to Italy to be broken up.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
