H. With reference to your memorandum of the 13th June last, and previous correspondence relative to the steamer "STYLIANOS GOUTSODONTIS" I have to acquaint you that the Owners Agents have requested the issue of a seaworthy certificate to enable this vessel to proceed from Salonica to Italy without survey, and in reply they have been informed that the Committee are unable to accede to this request and that should the vessel leave Salonica the case must be brought to the notice of the Committee with a view to the class being dealt with.
