I am in receipt of your letter of the 11th instant having further reference to the case of the steamer "STYLIANOS COUTSODONTIS", which vessel has been laid up at Salonica for some time past, and note therefrom that you are agreeable to the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus visiting the vessel with a view to their ascertaining whether she is in a fit condition to proceed to Italy, in ballast, for a repairing port or for a breaking-up port in that Country.
