

S.S. "STYLIANOS COUSODONTIS"

This case is fully stated in endorsement dated 9th instant when Messrs. Michalinos & Co. were informed of what would require to be done to enable a certificate to be issued to permit the vessel to proceed from Salonica to Italy to be broken up.

A letter has now been received from Messrs. Michalinos & Co. stating that they desire that the Piraeus Surveyors might be asked to state if they are still of the opinion that the vessel could leave without any further temporary repairs being effected. They add that they would be quite agreeable to the Surveyor seeing the ship, if he desires to do so, and that they would be responsible for paying his travelling expenses and fee.

It is submitted the Piraeus Surveyors be informed of the letter received from Messrs. Michalinos & Co. and be requested to make the necessary general examination, as stated in the Secretary's letter of 10th instant.
