

We are in receipt of your letter of yesterday, and have  
received all you have given us word of in the same.

In reply we beg to say that we shall probably require  
the ship to proceed from Salonica to Italy as a seaworthy ship, not  
as a repair ship, and that, in view of this, we would ask you to do  
us the favour of requesting the Society's Surveyor at Piraeus to say  
whether he is still of the opinion he held in September last, and which  
condition the ship could, in the condition she was then, or without  
further temporary repair done to her, leave Salonica in  
a repairing port, or, as we should now like him to say,  
a final port in Italy.

If the surveyor should wish to see the ship, we would,  
be quite agreeable to his doing so, and further, we would  
be responsible for the payment of his travelling expenses


